Camiguin Dive Day Trip

Camiguin is a beautiful, relatively unspoiled island off the coast of Bohol. Enjoy the beautiful surroundings on our 3 hour boat ride to this volcanic island. Camiguin actually has more volcanoes per square kilometer than any other island. There are a total of 7 volcanoes here.

Explore the beautiful and intriguing underwater world. One stop is the Sunken Cemetery. In the 1870s, Mt. Vulcan erupted and sunk part of the island, including the cemetery.
